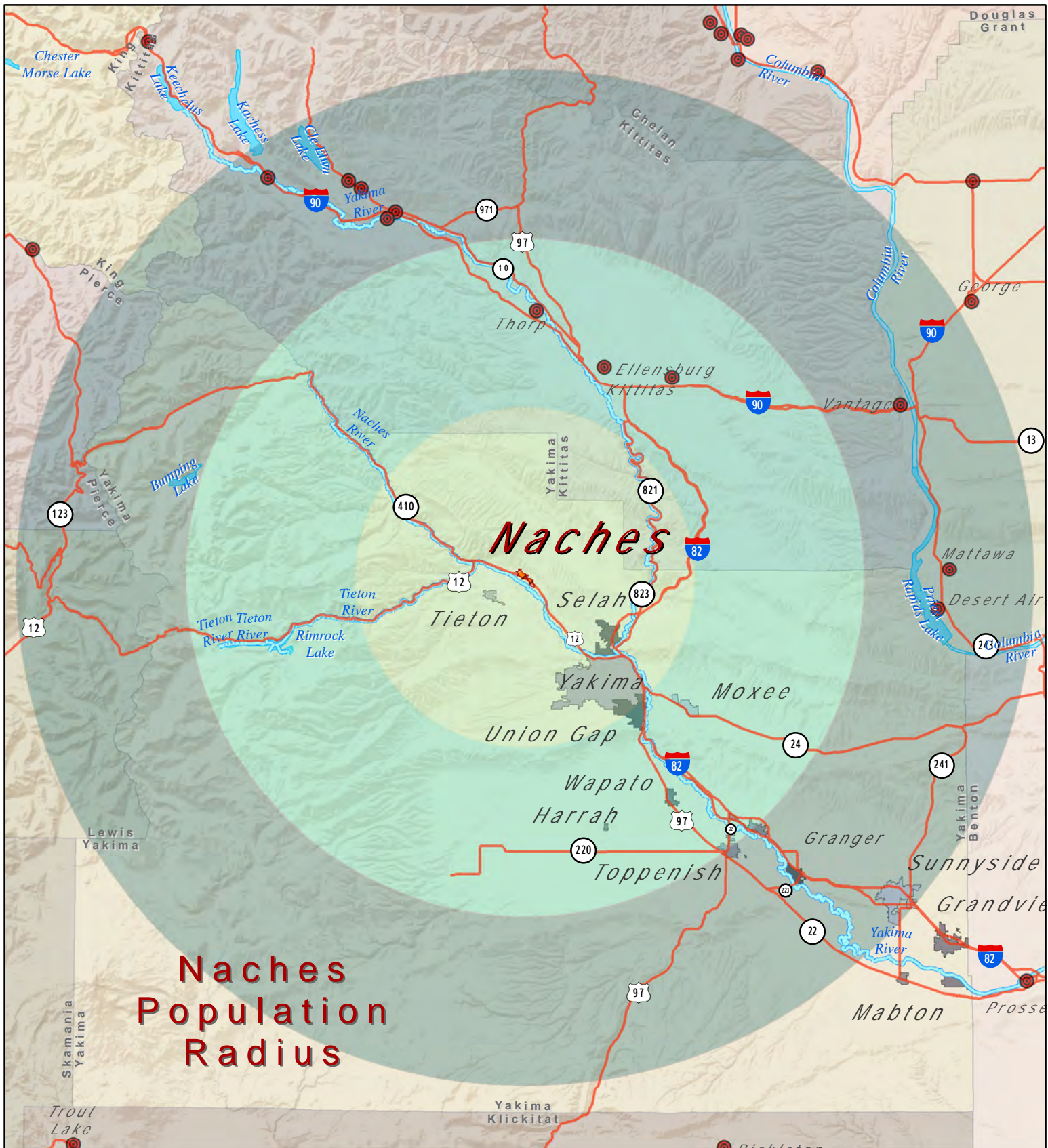

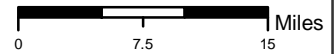


Naches Population Radius
