## **Local Pacific Steel Moves To New Location**

*State of the art facility improves steel services and adds recycling to Yakima plant*

**January 23, 2009 — Yakima, WA** — The Yakima branch of Pacific Steel and Recycling is pleased to announce they have completed their move to a new location at 409 Butterfield Road in Terrace Heights and have added recycling operations as part of their plan to continue providing optimal customer service in the Yakima area. The new location is much more accessible right off of Terrace Heights Drive.

The most significant change will be the addition of recycling. “We’re excited to offer recycling capabilities to Yakima and the surrounding area,” says Tim Orth, branch manager. “With our new facility, we offer area citizens and businesses additional opportunities to increase their commitment to a greener lifestyle. Mr. Orth continues, “We’ve added two new people to our Yakima staff and expect to add more positions over the next couple of years as our business continues to grow.”

Pacific accepts scrap metals including steel, tin, aluminum, copper, brass and aluminum cans. They will also take cardboard and most paper. Their recycling operations include a 12,000 square foot building with convenient drive-thru recycling.

The new location also includes a new 20,000 square foot steel warehouse and 1750 square foot office space. “We are pleased that Pacific Steel is expanding within our region’, said Yakima County Development Association President, Dave McFadden. “The company has been a great addition to our community and is now well positioned for future growth.”

New equipment to be found in the steel warehouse includes a 15 ton overhead crane, a band saw, and a plate shear. These additions will enhance the efficiency and accuracy of order processing as well as increase the plant’s ability to meet all of their customers’ needs.

Pacific Steel & Recycling is headquartered in Great Falls, Montana, and has 37 offices throughout the Intermountain Northwest. The company is the region’s largest Steel Service Center and Scrap Metals Recycler, with nine Steel Service Centers, 18 Steel Distribution Centers and 27 Recycling Centers throughout the Northern Rocky Mountains and northern plains.
