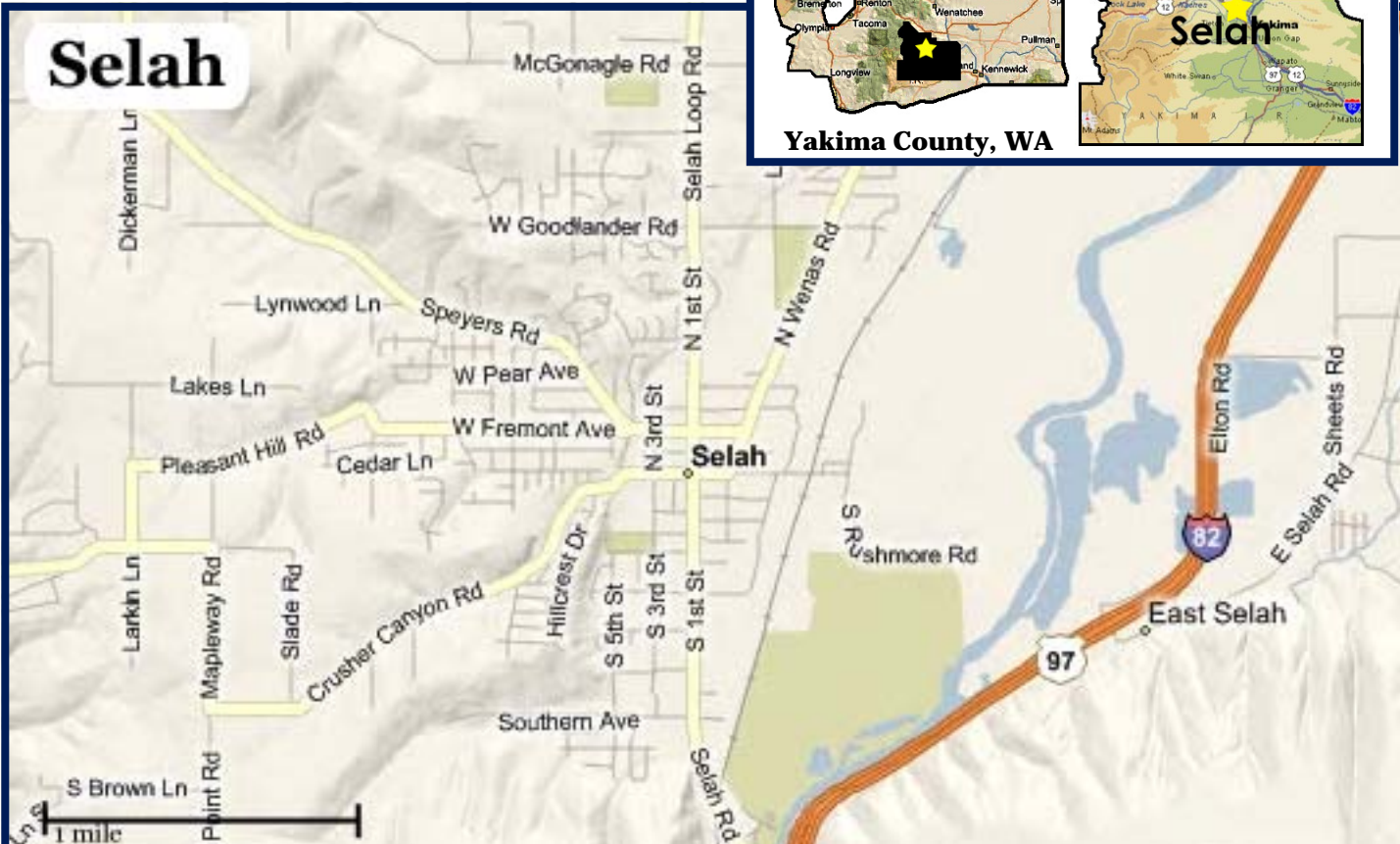

Location

Selah is two miles north of Yakima. It is approximately 145 miles from Seattle, 190 miles from Spokane and 195 miles from Portland with easy access to I-90, US Routes 12 and 97 and State Routes 22, 24, 241 & 410.

Quality of Life

Recreation: There are city parks, a swimming pool, and two golf courses in addition to skiing, hunting, fishing, boating, camping and major sports teams. Selah has parades, festivals, wineries, and an active city recreation program.

Housing: Median home price is \$140,000.

Healthcare: Selah has medical, dental, chiropractic and optometric practices and is within 10 minutes from the region's two major hospitals and several specialty clinics

Schools: The Selah School District includes two elementary schools, one intermediate school, one junior high, and two high schools enrolling 3,367 students.

Churches: Selah has churches of various denominations.
